3. How did God see Gideon's circumstances?
 - a. The angel of the Lord called him a **mighty warrior**.
4. What was Gideon's response?
 - a. He started making **excuses**.
5. What was the Lord's response to Gideon?
 - a. God reminded him that he was not **alone**.
 - b. Those who God **calls**, He **enables**
6. What will your response when you are called?
 - a. If you are asked to assist in Sunday School, will you serve?
 - b. If you are asked to serve as an usher, will you serve?
7. What will happen if you say yes?
 - a. The Lord will be with you, He will not **abandon** you.
 - b. If you are given a **responsibility** will you accept it as an **opportunity**?
 - c. You may be the next Kimball and lead someone to the Lord who will do great things for the Kingdom of God.
